The neck, which is the most important part of the sanshin, is made from wood such as ebony, and the price and tone vary depending on the type of wood. The body is made of a rubber wood frame over which artificial skin or real snakeskin is stretched, and the tone changes depending on how the skin is stretched and how tightly it is stretched.

The wood grain of the neck allows you to enjoy the beauty of the wood grain after the lacquer finish. As both a traditional musical instrument and a work of art, this is an item that tickles your fancy and makes you want to own it.





At Bisui Shoho, Nishijin-ori fabric is used for the waist wrap, enhancing the beauty of the sanshin and exciting the hearts of performers and spectators.

Please enjoy this collaboration that connects the spirit of Ryukyu with the spirit of Nishijin-ori in Kyoto.

The price range of sanshin varies depending on the material of the neck and body.

A wool blanket is placed on the inside to protect the drum skin from dryness and moisture.
